# Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Trustees Bloomington Township Public Water District June 10, 2025

Chairman Dan Wilcox called the regular monthly meeting of the Trustees of the Bloomington Township Public Water District to order at 6:45 p.m. on June 10, 2025.

Trustees present: Dave Baugh, Greg Allen, Renee Ponsonby, John Emmert, Tom Husek and Dan Wilcox.

Others present included: District Manager Micah Stickling and Treasurer Karen Williams.

Attorney Joe Dehn of Depew and Dehn Law firm joined the meeting via phone.

### **Previous Minutes Approval:**

Tom Husek made a motion to approve the May13, 2025 board meeting minutes: second by John Emmert. All ayes – motion carried.

## Monthly Bill Approval/Disbursements and Financial Reports:

The May disbursements to be approved were submitted by Treasurer Karen Williams.

Tom Husek made a motion to approve the May disbursements as presented: second by John Emmert. All ayes – motion carried.

During discussion of the financial statements, the trustees determined that when the next treasury note matures (June 15, \$150,000 treasury note), \$100,000 should be reinvested in a treasury note and \$50,000 should be transferred to the Busey operations checking account. This transfer will bring the operations checking account closer to the desired level of approximately \$100,000.

John Emmert made a motion to approve the draft financial statements as presented: second by Dave Baugh. All ayes – motion carried.

### Treasurer's Report

#### A. Fiscal Year 2026 Budget - Final

Treasurer Williams presented the final fiscal year 2026 budget which includes the final employee salary and compensation as approved by the trustees.

John Emmert made a motion to approve the final Fiscal Year 2026 budget with final salary and compensation included: second by Renee Ponsonby. All ayes – motion carried.

### B. Ordinance #11 - Publishing

Treasurer Williams informed the trustees that revised Ordinance #11 had been published in the Normalite paper in June.

## Manager's Report

## A. General Updates

- Non-Revenue water: Crestwicke nonrevenue water has increased this
  happened last year during the same time period. Micah will be replacing the
  meter at the pool house at the Crestwicke Country Club as a first step in trying to
  locate where the usage is occurring but not being metered. West Phase –
  difficult to determine at this point due to semi-annual flushing, the timing of
  the repair of the identified leak that was in Oak Hill, and the water main break on
  Jolly Lake Rd (900 East Rd.)
- Events during the Month of May: 1) Fiber boring company hit a service line on 1000 East Rd, 2) boring company hit a water main on Jolly Lake Rd. and 3) the City of Bloomington repaired a valve on a main that feeds Crestwicke – the PSI fell below 20 and a boil order was required for the entire Crestwicke system.

- Upcoming scheduled work: 1) Hydrant to be replaced on Rhodes Rd. 2) Hydrant to be replaced on Glenda Lane and 3) use of G.A. Rich for one day to assist with planned meter replacements.
- The permanent repair to a service line on Blooming Grove Road will be deferred until the next fiscal year.
- The CCR Report (consumer confidence report) has been completed and certification completed for the childcare lead and copper rule.
